



OSHA Inspections

Basic Information

Conduct a monthly in-house inspection and have a professional conduct an annual inspection. Be sure to document these inspections. The inspection should include, at minimum:

- Chemical storage areas
- Chemical equipment
- Any outdoor fuel storage tanks and areas
- Kitchen appliances
- Preparation room area equipment
 - , Eyewash stations
 - , Shower
 - , Refrigeration
 - , Casket and Body Lifts
 - , Respirators
 - , First Aid Kits
 - , All PPE
- Crematory equipment, where applicable
- Exit lighting
- Any appliance which uses natural gas, gasoline, electricity
- Smoke detectors
- Fire extinguishers
- Sprinkler systems
- Electrical cords
- Hoses
