FUNERAL DIRECTOR ONLY

To qualify for a Funeral Director Only license, the individual must submit the following information;

- 1. An official transcript indicating a Bachelor degree from an accredited college or university
- 2. Documentation of serving a two (2) year apprenticeship under the supervision of a licensed funeral director. During the apprenticeship, you must assist, under general supervision, in the arranging of thirty five (35) services and conduct not less than thirty five (35) disposition services.
- 3. Take and pass with an average score of not less than seventy-five percent, the West Virginia Laws, Rules and Regulations Examination.

RECIPROCITY REQUIREMENTS

An individual seeking a reciprocity funeral director license must submit the following to the office along with the application:

- 1. Have an official transcript submitted indicating completion of a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university
- 2. Submit verification of good standing of licensure from all states you are licensed
- 3. Submit verification of apprenticeship

An applicant seeking a funeral director reciprocity license must have held an active license or its equivalent to practice funeral directing in another state for at least the last 2 years or this can consist of a one (1) year apprenticeship and active license for one (1) year.
